We met donkeys, goats, sheep, chickens, geese, rabbits, tortoises, ducklings, and a pig! We learnt about how some of these farm animals produce resources for us and our community such as wool, eggs and milk, and how we can nurture futures with safe and sustainable farming. The farmers taught us how to correctly pet the farm animals and we enjoyed putting our new skills into practice, brushing and caring for the animals in their pens! We even learnt how to milk a cow using a cow udder replica model. Some of us enjoyed exploring the variety of animal poo that had been preserved in resin! It was an exciting experience and the children represented our school brilliantly with kindness and respect.
